Photographer Fien Muller and sculptor Hannes Van Severen are the husband and wife team behind furniture design company Muller Van Severen. The design duo had worked independently until an exhibition four years ago which saw Muller and Van Severen join forces to create a series of furniture. Since then, the company has been selected as guests at the *Interieur Design Biennale* in Kortrijk (2012), nominated for London's *Design Museum*'s Designs of the Year (2013), *Icon* magazine's Designer of the Year Award (2013), and *Wallpaper* magazine's Designer of the Year Award (2014).

Van Severen is the son of renowned Belgian furniture designer Maarten Van Severen and the grandson of abstract painter Dan Van Severen. The disciplined and minimalist lines of Muller Van Severen's output is reminiscent of Van Severen's lineage, while the quirky simplicity with a focus on materiality showcases the personal style of both Muller and Van Severen.

Despite the very structured designs that Muller Van Severen produce, the two admit to working in an entirely organic and intuitive manner. Artists by nature, instead of creating technical drawings or computer-generated images, the two create to-scale prototypes for each of their designs.
